

GEO-18 – 2-3 November 2022

New Members, Participating Organizations and Associates

This document is provided to GEO-18 Plenary for information. With these actions, the total number of GEO Members is 114; Participating Organizations is 144; and Associates is 19.

Membership in the Group on Earth Observations (GEO) is open to all Member States of the United Nations and to the European Commission. GEO also welcomes, as Participating Organizations, intergovernmental, international, and regional organizations, development banks, foundations, non-governmental organizations, and not-for-profit associations of commercial entities with a mandate and/or interest in, or be a user of Earth observations, information or services – that is the full spectrum, and/or value chain from data collection to use. While no approval is necessary for Member Countries, acceptance of Participating Organizations and Observers is subject to approval by the GEO Executive Committee.

Since the last Plenary, the following actions have taken place.

• 114th Member: The Democratic Republic of Congo, effective 1 January 2023.
