

EARTH OBSERVATIONS FOR THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

UN HABITAT FOR A BETTER URBAN FUTURE

- GEO & UN-Habitat (among others) developing an EO Toolkit for SDG 11
- Build dataset/tool inventory with practical guidance for EO & SDG 11/New Urban Agenda
- To be integrated into UN-Habitat portal & GEO Knowledge Hub
 - Received 57 applications from countries & cities, including NSOs, academia/research networks, municipalities
 - Two evaluation rounds completed
 - Selection of use cases (1st group maturity of use case, 2nd group innovation/perspectives, geographical balance)
 - A Steering Committee for the "Earth Observation Toolkit for Sustainable Cities and Communities" is being established


GEO Community Activity - Climate Change Impacts on World Heritage Cities

Open invitation by GEO Member Greece in collaboration with UNESCO

The Group on Earth Observations announced an initial, open invitation to gauge the interest and support of the GEO community to propose a Community Activity, incorporating urban cultural heritage aspects into the 2020-2022 Work Programme, in cooperation with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

The deadline was on 31st July 2020
