- Development of an overarching Engagement Strategy
- Participation by members / PICTs in a range of activities promoting
   GEO-PICTs engagement
  - in line with the PIAG TORs and detailed PIAG work plan
- Several significant developments/opportunities:
  - Digital Earth Pacific & EO in the Pacific Needs Assessment
  - Engagement with Asia Oceania GEO
  - New GEO members, and increased engagement by existing PICT members



### **PIAG draft Engagement Strategy**

- Draft Engagement Strategy outline (Annex A)
  - A series of actions and opportunities to increase and improve GEO⇔ PICT connections
  - Highlights links between goals of GEO (Canberra Declaration) and the PICTs (Talanoa Statement on EO)
  - Links PIAG TORs to proposed activities and associated deliverables
  - 5 areas of focus: Scoping, Consulting, Connecting, Aligning and Advising



Goal: Support GEO Ministerial Summit Declaration, "Welcome new Members from the Pacific and other island nations to the GEO community, and recognise the significant capabilities they have to offer.
