# Key events GEO ↔ PICTs

- **2019**
  - GEO Week 2019 ↔ GEO Ministerial Summit Declaration
  - GEO Week Pacific Island Program ↔ EO in the Pacific Talanoa Statement
- **2020**
  - Establishment of the Pacific Island Advisory Group (PIAG) to GEO Executive Committee
  - Endorsement of the PIAG Terms of Reference by ExCOM 53
- **2021**
  - AO GEO Symposium, GEO Week 2021
  - Draft PIAG Engagement Strategy & Workplan => ExCOM 55



# Primary activities of PIAG in 2021

- Ongoing efforts to **develop and refine PIAGs work plan**
- Development of an **overarching Engagement Strategy**
- Participation by members / PICTs in a **range of activities promoting GEO-PICTs engagement**
  - in line with the **PIAG TORs** and detailed **PIAG work plan**
- Several **significant developments/opportunities**:
  - Digital Earth Pacific & EO in the Pacific Needs Assessment
  - Engagement with Asia Oceania GEO
  - New GEO members, and increased engagement by existing PICT members

# PIAG draft Engagement Strategy

- **Draft Engagement Strategy outline ([Annex A](#))**
  - **A series of actions and opportunities** to increase and improve GEO ↔ PICT connections
  - **Highlights links between goals** of GEO (Canberra Declaration) and the PICTs (Talanoa Statement on EO)
  - **Links PIAG TORs to proposed activities and associated deliverables**
  - **5 areas of focus:** Scoping, Consulting, Connecting, Aligning and Advising

**Goal: Support GEO Ministerial Summit Declaration**, “Welcome new Members from the Pacific and other island nations to the GEO community, and recognise the significant capabilities they have to offer. Emphasise the importance of GEO being inclusive of these countries with their significant and increasing exposure to disaster risk, climate change and sustainable development challenges”, **in line with the priorities of the EO in the Pacific Talanoa Statement.**

  - Deep consultation with SPREP as existing GEO PO
  - GEO Week 2021 side event
- **CONNECT** the PICTs ↔ GEO technical EO activities
  - Digital Earth Pacific accepted as GEO Community Activity
  - USP ↔ GRSS on MOOC
  - AO GEO Symposium session *“Satellite data for the Pacific Islands: Supplier and User perspectives”*
- **Align** with relevant UN Agendas
  - Ongoing discussions with UN SPIDER
  - Opportunities to link SPREP EO ↔ SDGs
