

Target Regions & Areas

Mekong River / Pacific Island Countries / Himalayan Mountains

Implementation period

2023-2025 GEO Work

Expected Outcome

- Strengthen the collaboration among multiple country members, including experts and decision-makers.
- Develop use cases that show how EO data have served in decision-making in the region.
- Consolidate as new activities to apply to GEO "Pilot Initiatives" (Early-stage collaborated study)
