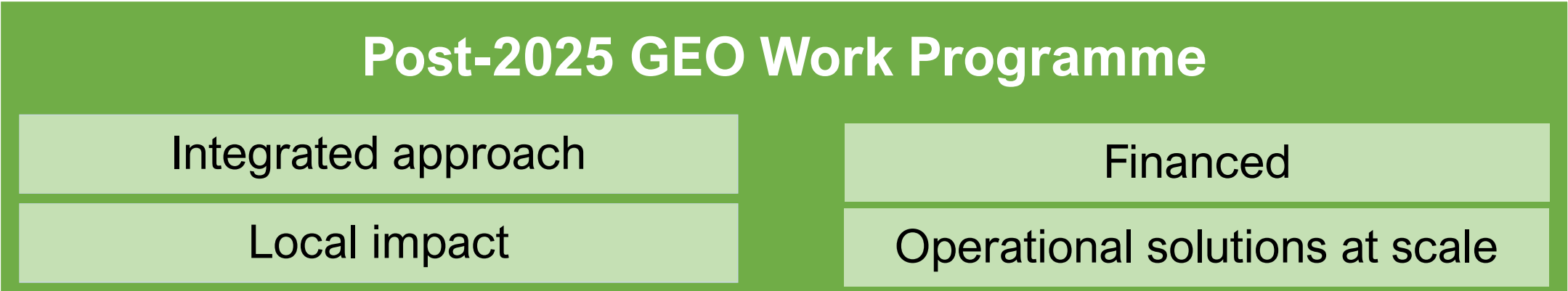
## Post-2025 Incubators

- The Post-2025 incubators are experimental integration efforts between GWP activities and other partners under nexus or thematic area(s) and across the Earth observations value chain.
- The incubation goal is to co-design demand-driven integrated solutions to pressing and complex global challenges. Incubators are identified on the basis of:
  - established demand (as represented by major global policy agendas and other global developments);
  - availability of science-based operational fit-for-purpose capabilities developed by GEO, and complemented by efforts of other partners;
  - nexus-based orientation and/or integration along the value chain will ensure the approach recognizes the complexity of global challenges; and
  - prospective donor interest

## Identifying and developing future Post-2025 Incubators

- The draft Post-2025 Strategy aims to co-produce transformative programmes for trusted Earth Intelligence.
- Post-2025 incubators are experimental integration efforts between GEO Work Programme activities and other partners, under thematic areas and across the Earth observation value chain. The objective is to inform the design of the Post-2025 GEO Work Programme
- Two incubators are currently being supported to achieve integration across thematic areas and the Earth observations value chain.
- Lessons learned include the need for dedicated support and capacity building to ensure successful development and sustainability of the incubators.
