Background

- The 2023 GEO Awards will strive to acknowledge and celebrate both outstanding individuals and impactful teams.
 - **Team award** - Ensures a fair and inclusive recognition process that better captures the value of collaboration and collective contributions within the GEO community.
 - **Emerging leader award** - Youth engagement was highlighted during the 2023 Symposium.
- Maximum of two awardees per category. The criteria for these awards include elements from the Individual **Excellence** Award criteria by the Programme Board in 2019.

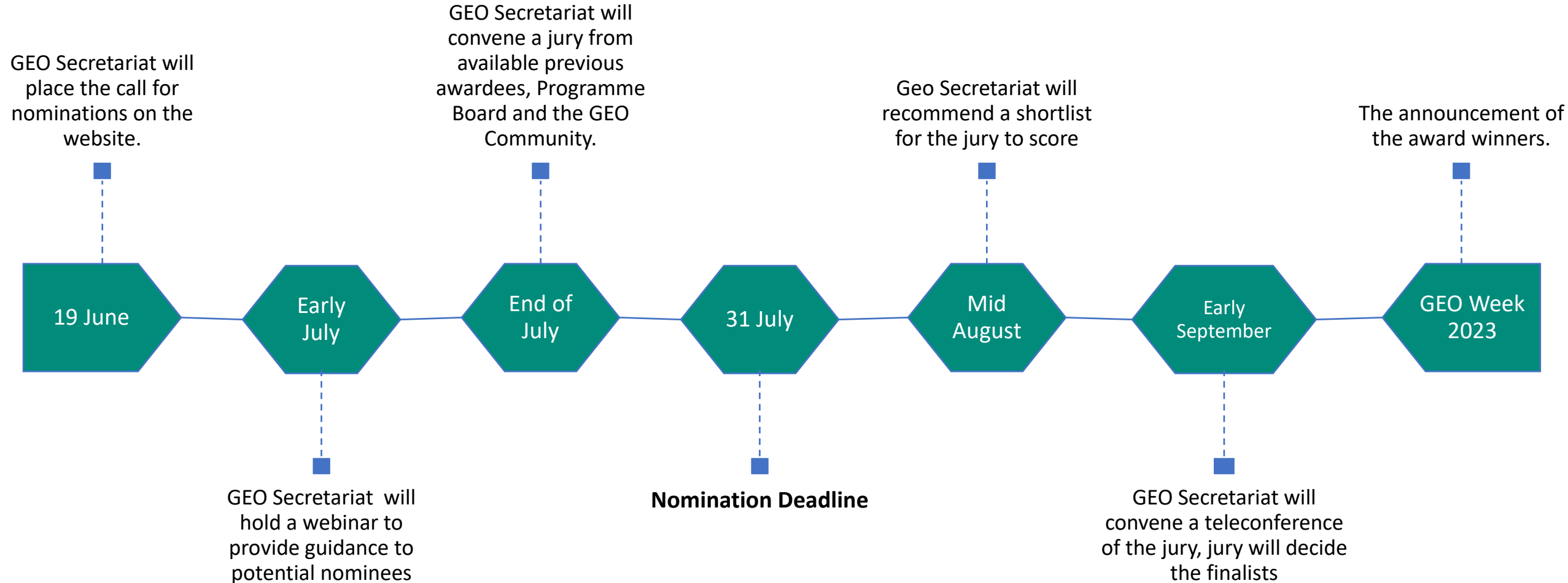
