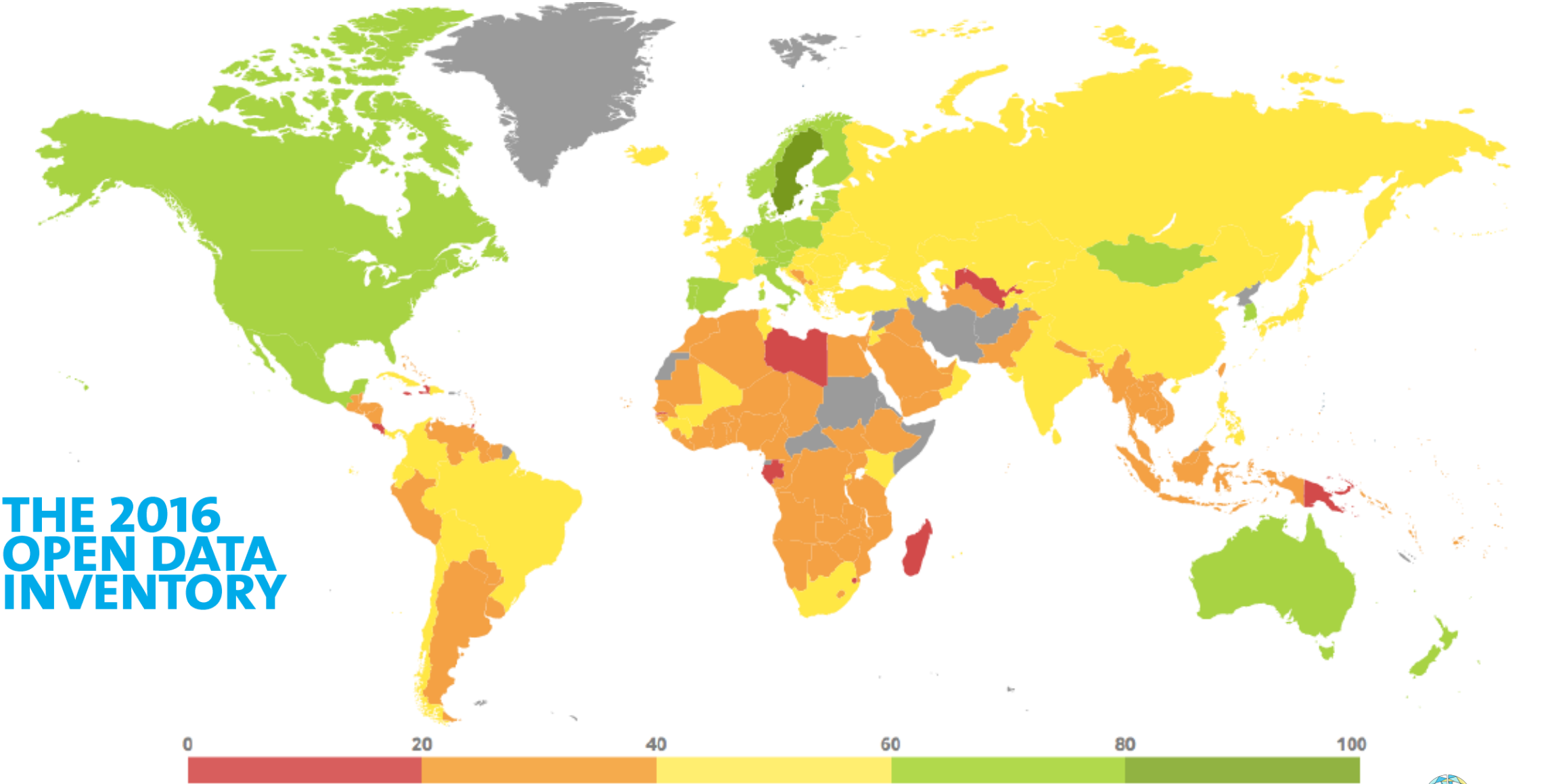
Open data is defined as data that is:

- For inclusive development and innovation

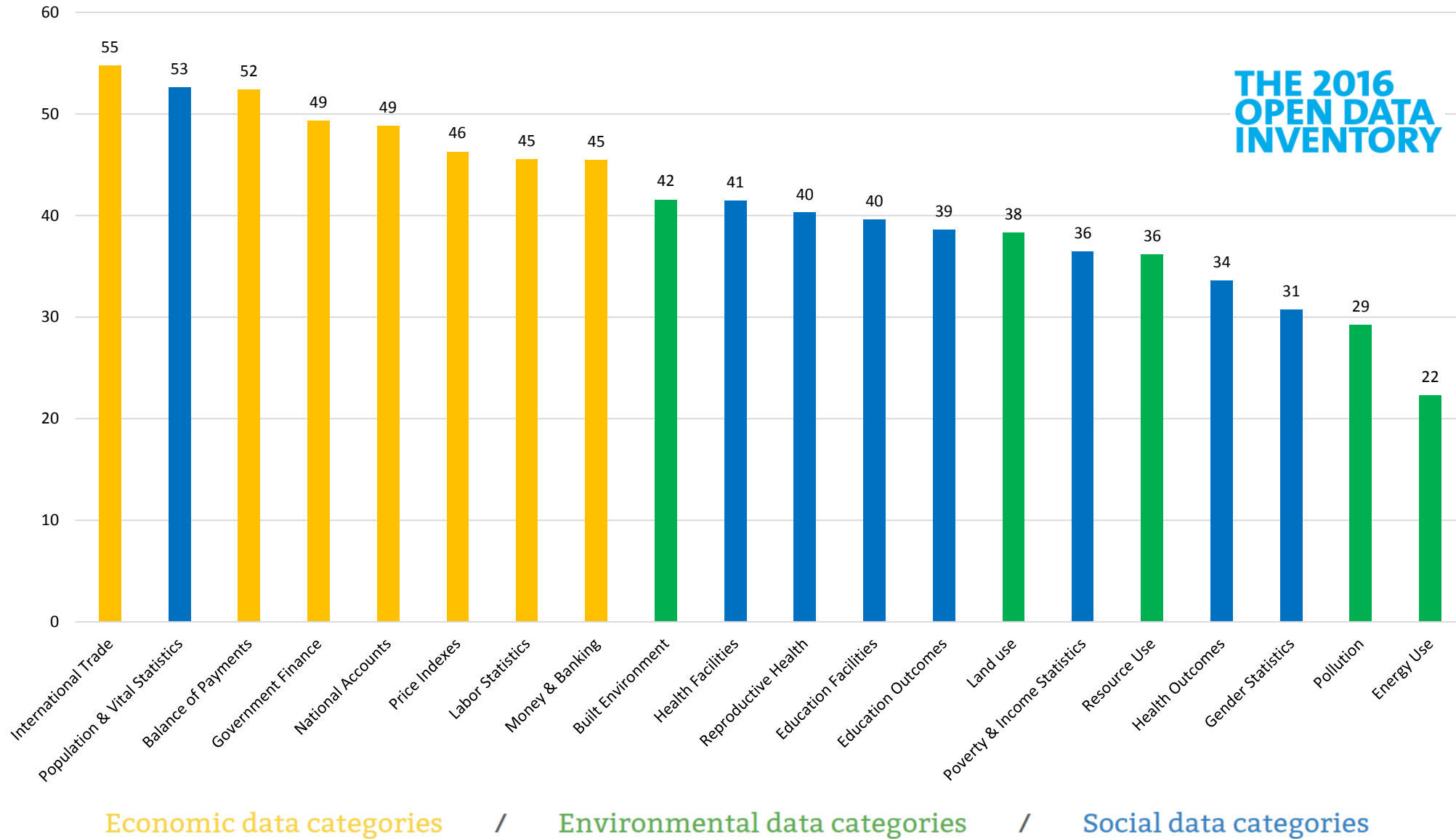

- The UN Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics, 2014



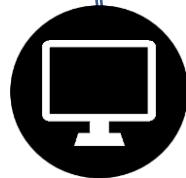

Use NSDS to map the new strategy, including newly required legal and governance frameworks



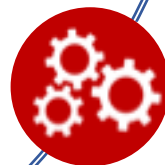
Promote partnerships for data interoperability and integration with GEO data



Protect data privacy and security



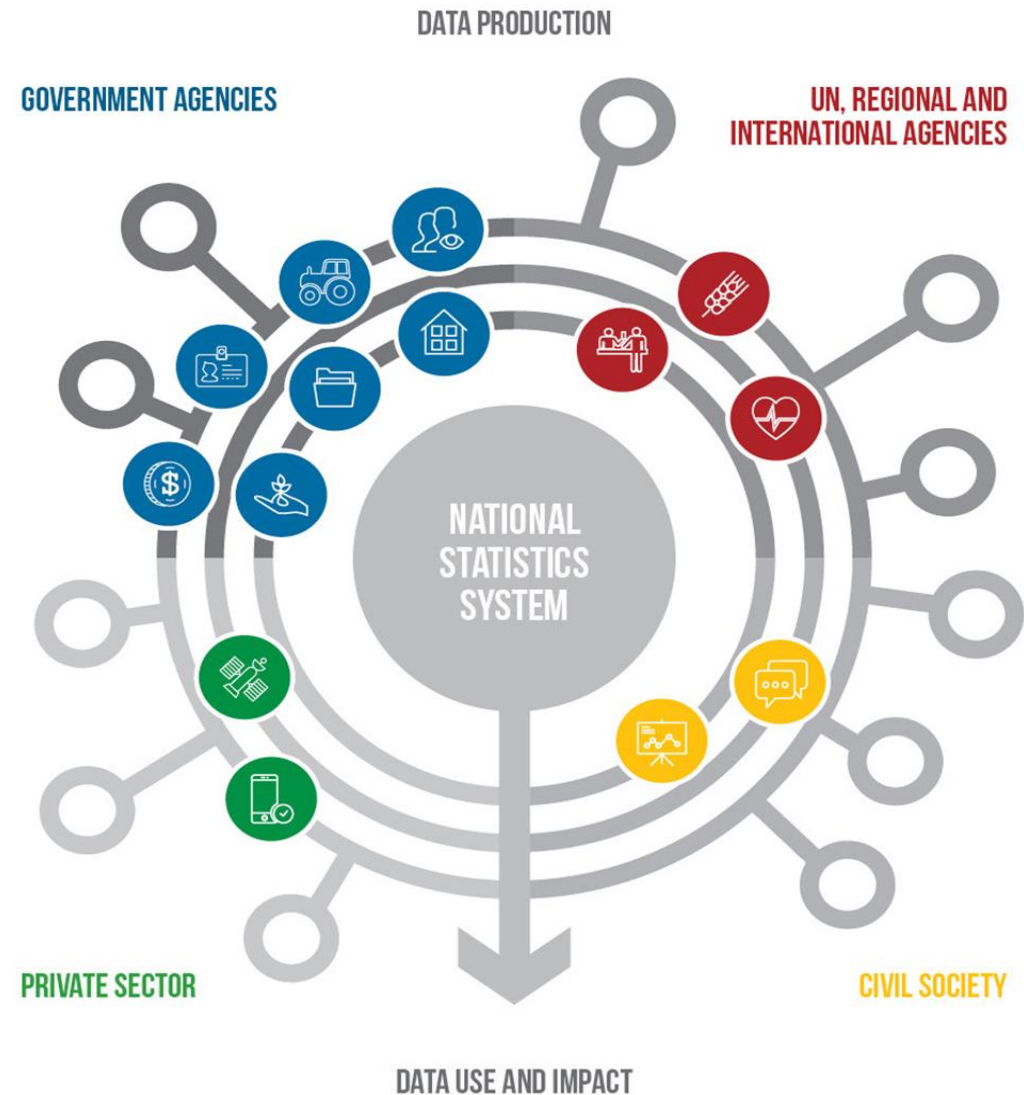
Build capacity at all levels including to raise funds
